LFC have adopted the definition of Safety Critical Workers as set out in the Constructing Better Health 'Occupational Health Standards for the UK Construction Industry' document and Regulatory specific documentation (such as BS 7121).

Who is safety critical?



Medicals cover

- Health assessment questionnaire
- BMI
- Blood pressure and pulse
- Urinalysis (glucose)
- Near and distance vision screening
- Colour vision
- Lung function (spirometry)
- Musculoskeletal assessment
- Skin assessment
- Audiometry

Statistics –

- **Over 250 persons medicals completed to date on the project (most on site in purpose set up occupational health room).**
- **Voluntary well-being medicals also offered to all on site i.e. non safety critical workers).**

Frequencies

- Aged between 30 and 54, every 5 years.
- Aged between 55 and 64, every 2 years.
- Aged 65 and over, every year.
- If a medical and evidence is in place prior to site induction no need of further medical until time frame requires.
